Methods of Payment

You are able to pay the course fees in full or in instalments as above. We accept payment by bank transfer/BACS, credit card, cash and cheques.



Registration Fee

On acceptance of your offer of a place you will need to pay a non-refundable or transferable registration fee of £100.



Additional Course Costs

You will need to buy some additional compulsory course books as highlighted on the reading list provided. These books can be bought online from our [bookstore](#). Course modules are available online or can be bought as hard copy from the shop.



Student Finance: For students to be eligible for SLC funding they must be studying on a designated course. Courses at this college are designated each year by the Department for Education. [Visit this site](#) for advice and guidance.



Foundation Degree and Cert HE students can apply for a student loan to cover the cost of your tuition fees, which will be paid directly to MCI. You will only pay the £100 registration fee up front. Once you leave your course, you'll only repay when your income is above the repayment threshold. The current UK threshold is £25,000 a year, £2,083 a month or £480 a week.
